A STAFFING NOTE FROM SCHOOL COUNCIL: We wanted to share a staffing update with you. Some of you may have noticed on the CISPG website that there was a posting for the principal position at St. Joseph's. This was because Monique Vanderwart's two year contract was scheduled to end as of July 31st. We are pleased to share that she expressed an interest in continuing and will continue to be our principal moving forward.

SPRING PLANT FUNDRAISER: Today each student received a plant fundraiser form. If you are interested in participating in this fundraiser for the school, please fill out the form, receive the payment and return it to the office. Orders and payment are due on April 15th Funds raised go towards student activities. The plates are a nice way to start the spring/summer season. Each participant will get their names entered into a draw for a prize. Student with the most sold will receive a \$50.00 gift certificate to a store of their choice. WE'RE HIRING!:

It's that time of year again where we start planning for next year. Based on what we know so far, St. Joseph's is looking to hire for the following teaching positions:

1.0 FTE Intermediate grades. Specific grade level dependent on the candidate and internal staffing re-arrangements. 1.0 FTE French/Music This can be a full-time position, or French and Music can be broken apart into two part time positions, or French and Music can be broken apart and paired with a classroom assignment. Specific assignment dependent on the candidate's strengths and internal staffing re-arrangements.

0.2-0.4 FTE intermediate grade: specific grade dependent on the candidate and internal staffing re-arrangements.

Update: We also anticipate the need to hire two full time support staff.
